DHS approved "Foundations Training for Caregivers" for families considering foster care adoption

Boys & Girls Aid is offering pre-adoption orientations and a weekend training series for families considering foster care adoption.

★ STEP 1: ORIENTATION

Orientation is an excellent way to become acquainted with the adoptive process, to learn more about the children who wait, and to further explore special needs adoption. This orientation is recommended, but not required before attending training. It is held the second Tuesday of each month.

★ STEP 2: TRAINING

Enroll in one of our pre-adoption training classes. Each class is a 3-day series that is offered as a means of helping prospective parents to develop further insight into their capacity for adopting special needs children. This training fulfills a Oregon DHS requirement for adopting children in state care.
